Dear praying friends,

Last year, we were saying goodbye to our family and preparing to make the move to Korea. Now, we have spent our first whole year following God's will as missionaries in South Korea. What feels like so little time has really flown right by. We have been actively studying the language and getting used to the culture and people. There are many times that we become frustrated by what seems to be a lack of progress, but looking back, it is incredible to remember just how helpless we were in this foreign country one year ago.

On Tuesday, April 21st, we welcomed our third child, Madison Rose, into the world! Kaitlyn was induced that morning (on what was 4 days after her due date) and had a smooth delivery. We praise God for the speedy labor and good health. Both Kaitlyn and Madison are doing just fine and are taking advantage of any downtime to rest. Nathan is very excited to have a baby sister, but Logan does not yet show much interest in her. From here on, we enter the preparations of applying for her American citizenship, passport, and Social Security number. There are many documents that we must gather and even an interview that Kaitlyn, Madison and I must attend at the US embassy in Seoul. Our hope is to attend this interview next Thursday. Please pray for us as we prepare the necessary documents and for God's grace so that the process moves smoothly and swiftly.

As of right now, I am going through somewhat of a change of Korean teachers. Since November, I have been learning under a Chosunjok (an ethnic Korean raised in China near the NK border) woman from a nearby church. I have enjoyed these lessons and seen encouraging progress to my speaking and comprehension ability since starting lessons under her. Unfortunately, she is unable to continue teaching me. My teacher's pastor has stepped up to help teach me, but with his busy schedule and other priorities, it does not seem like it would be a long-term option. Please pray for wisdom and guidance on my behalf that God would lead me to a Korean teacher that would help me to learn the language regularly and in the way that works best for me.
