## Missionaries to South Korea

Dear praying friends,

Happy New Year from the Delaney family! The change to 2026 reminds me of two of the goals that we have for the years ahead in our ministry in South Korea. Firstly, we hope to learn the language to a level where we can easily and proficiently explain the gospel message to the lost through witnessing and preaching. Secondly, we are praying for God's will concerning where we ought to plant an independent, fundamental, Bible-believing Korean Baptist church. My prayer is similar to what Paul says in Romans 15:20, *"Yea, so have I strived to preach the gospel, not where Christ was named, lest I should build upon another man's foundation."* There are many places in Korea, particularly the southern half of the country, where there are no likeminded churches that Christians can go to. It is my desire that God would lead us to plant a church in one of these cities.

We have learned this past month that we will be having a baby girl! We are so excited for this new addition to our family! We do not have a definitive due date since South Korea measures the due date differently, but we are expecting this third child in April. We thank God that everything looks healthy and normal and we pray that we continue to get similar reports.

We have had opportunities recently to fill the pulpit for other men in their ministries. As the weather has gotten colder, we have also begun distributing John and Romans to many of the *jutaeks* (small houses and apartment buildings) around the area at Maranatha. I am thankful that God is still willing to use us while we are limited in our ability and understanding to reach the lost and serve our God. While serving in these ministries, I have recently felt God correcting my spirit to be more like Him. The difference in personality or habits between where I am and what I am used to can lead to frustration and a cold heart if not careful. In addition to the previously mentioned requests, please pray on our behalf that our hearts would be tender, our spirits would be patient, and our desires after the mind of Christ.
